ORDER OF COURT	

Upon consideration of the Petition for Rule to Show Cause Pursuant to C.A.R. 21, along with the Answer Briefs and Reply Brief filed in the above cause, and now being sufficiently advised in the premises, the Court states the following:

In its Answer to the Court’s Order and Rule to Show Cause, the trial court states that changed circumstances “may render it appropriate to release the affidavits of probable cause in redacted form.”

Accordingly, we REMAND this case to the trial court for the limited purpose of determining whether its order denying Petitioners’ motion to unseal the affidavits should be reconsidered in light of changed circumstances. Upon reconsideration of the motion to unseal, the matter is to be recertified to this court.
