**Order: Motion for Non-Disclosure of Autopsy Report**

The motion/proposed order attached hereto: SEE ATTACHED ORDER.

The Court has carefully reviewed all filings in regards to this request as well as the arrest warrant, issued February 19, 2019, almost a full year to the date the deceased was found. The arrest warrant is over 30 pages long. Mr. Solano states it is against the public interest to release the autopsy report and cites argument to include: it is highly prejudicial and will taint the jury pool, there are graphic descriptions of the murder, there are pending investigation into possible co defendants. The Court finds that within the arrest warrant are names of over a dozen individuals who allegedly had contact with the defendant and provided information to law enforcement. Perhaps more compelling to the Court is the amount of detail within the arrest warrant about the autopsy that was conducted. Additionally the arrest warrant at time of issuance was not requested to be sealed and it has been provided to the press as requested and within the rules of SCAO. The Court finds no compelling reason to grant the motion for non disclosure of the autopsy report at this point as the information Mr. Solano states should not be disclosed has already been disclosed. Therefore, the motion for non-disclosure of the autopsy report is DENIED. It is to be provided no later than 5 PM on Tuesday, June 18, 2019 as requested.
